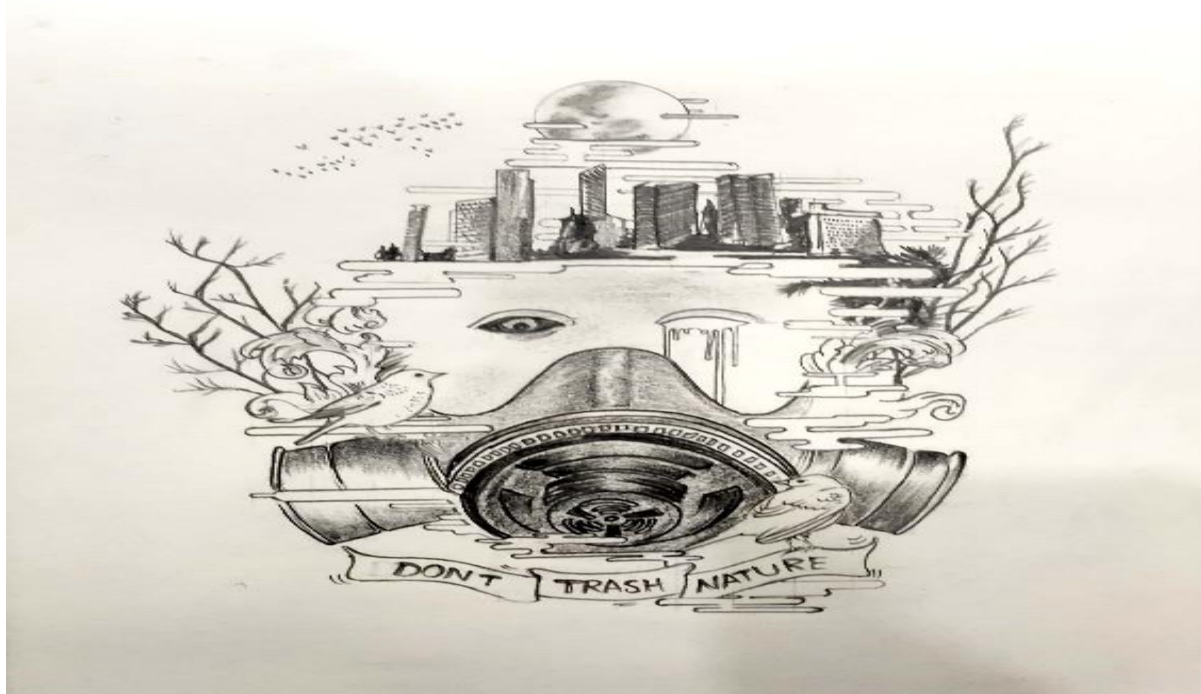
Awareness program on usage of plastic in Cheeryal

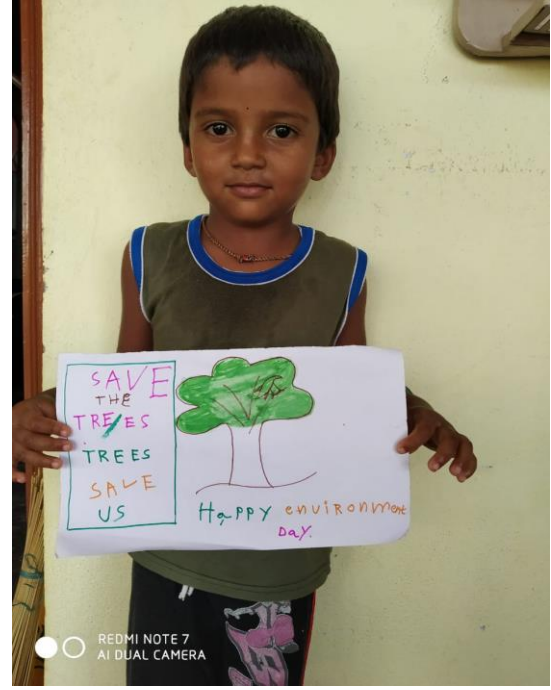
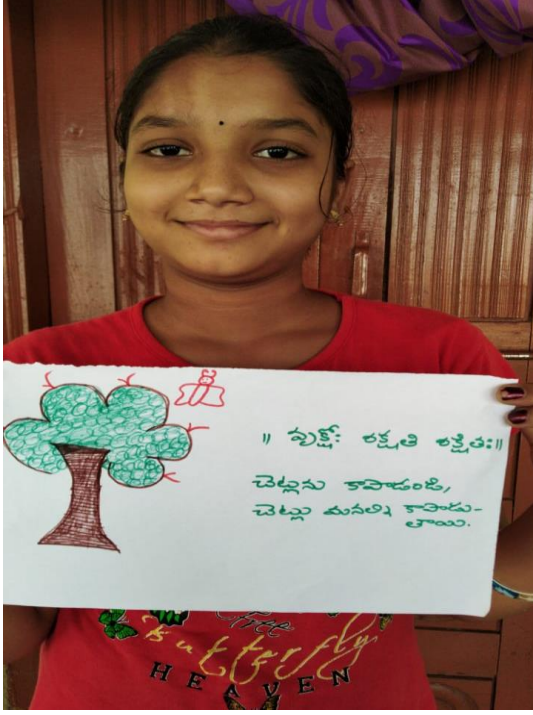
Report PPT's on Awareness program on Environment
