REPORT

The Literary Club issued a circular on Dt-29.07-2022 to organize Dum Charade, Spell Bee and Essay Writing Competition on the occasion of **'Independence Week'** for all B.Tech & MBA students. The club organised all the activities in ELCS Lab at 2.50 pm. Students were informed to prepare on all the terms related to Independence. Students showed their interest to participate in all the three activities conducted on different dates i.e. on 4^{th} , 5^{th} , and 6^{th} August 2022.

The first activity Dum Charade was conducted in ELCS Lab at 2.50 pm. Total 30 students gathered at the venue and the activity started at 3.00 pm. The students from different branches participated in this activity very enthusiastically. The student coordinators started the event and gave a brief idea about the different rounds of the event. The event was judged by Dr Rajitha Nair. In the 1st round out of the total participants, 9 teams were formed and each team consists of 3 to 4 students. The participants were given clue of Patriotic Movies where the students enacted the name of the movies either Hindi or Telugu movies like Border, Kargil, 1942 A Love Story, Khadgam, Alluri Seetharama Raju, Tagore, Mangal Pandey, Shaheed, Maa Tujhe Salaam, Bhagat Singh. The same team members were given 40 seconds time to guess the movie. In 2nd round, the students were given some of the renowned Freedom Fighters personalities like Jhansi Rani Lakshmi Bai, Kamala Nehru, Lal Bal Pal, Subhash Chandra Bose. The participants who were selected for this round were given 50 seconds to guess the name of freedom fighter name. Finally, the judge selected three participant names who answered in less time and finalised the winners' name.

On 5th of August 2022, the second activity Spell Bee was conducted in ELCS Lab at 2.50 pm. Total 12 students gathered at the venue and participated in this activity very enthusiastically. In the 1st round students were given clue of all the Patriotic terms. The coordinator dictated some of the patriotic terms like sovereignty, valiant, non-alignment, martyr, colonialism Massacre, steadfast, suffrage, abolitionist.

The students were given a paper to write 10 such words. The faculty coordinator pronounced the words in both American and British pronunciation along with the meaning of the word. The participants those who scored more than 40% were selected for the next round. In this round each student was given a difficult word which the participant had to write on the board like subjugation, chauvinism, incarceration, manumission, immurement, emancipation. Finally, three students were selected as winners.

On 6th August 2022, the third activity Essay Writing was conducted in ELCS Lab at 2.50 pm.
