**Suggestions given in the current meeting**

Registrar, JNTUH Dr. N. Yadaiah suggested to include "Human Values and Professional ethics (HVPE)" as a mandatory TWO (2) credit course. Dr. P.G.Sastry and Mr. Y.Srinivas, external members have also concurred with the suggestion of Dr. N.Yadaiah. All other members of Academic Council also concurred with this.

Registrar, JNTUH Dr. N. Yadaiah further suggested the following:

- "Microprocessors and Microcontrollers" course should be offered as a mandatory course for B. Tech EEE students.
- "Image Processing" course may be offered as an elective.
- "Computer Methods in Power Systems" course in the Final Year may be offered as a core course for B. Tech EEE students.
- "Embedded Systems" course may be offered as an elective or as an additional course for B. Tech EEE.
- "Energy Audit" course may be offered as an elective for B. Tech EEE students.
- "Static and Adjustable Speed Drives" course should be renamed as "Electric Drives" for B. Tech EEE students.
- Title of the open elective course "Modern Wireless Communication" should be changed as "Principles of Wireless Communication"

- “Disaster Management” course, being offered as an open elective may be offered as a mandatory minor course, if possible.
- To accommodate open electives in III Year II sem to provide more time for major project in IV Year II sem

Dr K. Rama Mohan Rao, JNTUH nominee suggested that

- “Building Technology” course offered as “Open Elective” for all other disciplines of B Tech except for civil engineering. This course has topics on advanced technologies which were not included in the course "Building Materials and Construction" of second year civil engineering. Hence, those topics may be included in "Building Materials and Construction" course syllabus of second year Civil engineering.

Registrar, JNTUH, Dr N. Yadhiah and External Expert member Dr P. G. Sastry also felt that the suggestions given by Dr K. Rama Mohan Rao may be addressed and such topics may be included in the curriculum of "Building Materials and Construction" course. Principal mentioned that the course is now under progress for Second year Civil Engineering students and not possible to revise the same. Principal further mentioned that those topics proposed will be given as "Value Added Course" to the students and the syllabus for the course shall be revised in the next revision of the curriculum.

Registrar, JNTUH, Dr N. Yadhiah also suggested the following:

- “Software Engineering” course may be offered for all the branches of B. Tech students.
- Uniformity in evaluation with 100 marks across all courses including Major Project.
- Revision of the syllabus to be done only after one batch of students under "Autonomous Status" of the college graduates from the college.
- Revamp the existing student feedback mechanism to understand to what extent the objectives are achieved. To add the status of the syllabus covered and whether the desired outcomes are attained.
- Orientation Program to be given to the young faculty for effective teaching-learning-process.
- “Telecommunications Switching Systems and Networks” course may be offered as "Open Elective".

- “Digital Signal Processing” course may be offered as an elective and instead “Power System Operation and Control” being offered as an elective, to be offered as a Core Course for B.Tech EEE students.

Under “any other item” of the agenda, Principal requested the members to consider adoption of the revised grading system suggested by JNTUH vide letter dated, May 16, 2017 for all "Autonomous Colleges" and "Affiliated Colleges" under JNTUH, and the members concurred with the same. Accordingly, the Academic Regulations (AR16) of GCET under “Autonomous Status” has been updated for distribution to the students.
